The new regulations will require that educators assist children in brushing their teeth whenever they are in care for more than four (4) hours or whenever they consume a meal while in care. It will require that the program/provider put a written policy in place for teeth brushing. Join us to learn ways to implement oral health practices into your child care program’s daily routine.
